## Proper Sharps Disposal

Sharps are safest when placed in an FDA approved container. If one is not available, you can make one from an empty household container.

The container should have these characteristics:

- Made from sturdy, rigid plastic (example: used laundry detergent bottle)
- Does not tip over
- Has a cap that does not puncture easily
- Does not have any leaks

When the container is 3/4 the way full, place the cap on it and tape it shut. Write on the outside "SHARPS". Bring your container to any of our Household Hazardous Waste events.

***Sharps containers should NEVER go in your curbside recycling bin or any of the drop off recycling locations.*** Used sharps and the containiers that contain them are **NOT** recyclable.

If you are unable to bring them to a HHW event they can be placed in your curbside garbage.


## International Compost Awareness Week is May 6-12

International Compost Awareness Week (ICAW) is the largest and most comprehensive education initiative of the compost industry. It is celebrated nationwide and in other countries each year during the first full week of May. Started in Canada in 1995,

ICAW has continued to grow as more people, businesses, municipalities, schools and organizations are recognizing the importance of composting and the long-term benefits from organics recycling.

The goal of the program is to raise the awareness of the public regarding the benefits of using compost to improve or maintain high quality soil, to grow healthy plants, reduce the use of fertilizer and pesticides, improve water quality and protect the environment. The program includes a poster contest, programs at schools and activities and events promoted through governments, public municipalities and local businesses nationwide.
